Community

Logos International School serves the educational needs of a diverse group of families in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. Students come from local Cambodian families, missionary families, and other expatriate families.

School

Logos International School is a comprehensive school enrolling 370 students in grades Pre-K through twelve. The school opened in the fall of 2002 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 2008. Logos is accredited by the **Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI)** and the **Western Association of Colleges and Schools (WASC)**.

Mission Statement

Logos International School is dedicated to academic excellence in providing a well-rounded, quality Christian education to students from all ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds. Upon graduation, students will be equipped to view all aspects of life from a biblical perspective, to serve and help transform their communities for Christ, and to pursue further education.

Faculty

The faculty comprises approximately 30 teaching professionals. Nationalities represented include American, Australian, British, Cambodian, Canadian, Korean, South African, and Filipino.

Curriculum

The curriculum standards are adopted from Virginia State, U.S. The secondary academic program is organized on a modified block schedule with students enrolled in 8 classes per semester that meet 3 times per week for 65 minutes.

English Language Proficiency

English is the primary language of instruction at Logos. Therefore, all of our students possess sufficient proficiency in the English language to participate successfully in a college or university where English is the primary language of instruction.

Graduation Requirements

A minimum of 29 credits is required for graduation. 0.5 credit = 1 semester; 1 credit = 1 year. Graduation requirements include:

- 4 credits (4 years) English
- 3 credits (3 years) Mathematics
- 3 credits (3 years) Science
- 3 credits (3 years) Social Studies
- 0.5 credit (1/2 year) Health
- 2 credits (2 years) Foreign Language
- 2 credits (2 years) Fine or Performing Arts
- 1 credit (1 year) Computers/IT
- 1.5 credits (1.5 years) Physical Education
- 1 credit (1 year) Bible for each year at Logos.
